- Adjunct FSA Members (Markers, Student Employees and Guest Lecturers) are not eligible to be a candidate for a Director position.
- All Members may *nominate* and *vote* for these positions.

• The Directors-at-Large, Directors-Associate Members, and Treasurer positions will serve a two (2) year term from June 1, 2019 until May 31, 2021.
