ELIGIBILITY

- Full-time FSA members are eligible to be a candidate for the President and Vice President positions.
- Associate FSA members (this includes all current Part-time Studies Instructors and Lab Assistants) are not eligible to be a candidate for the President and Vice President positions.
- Ancillary FSA members (Markers, Student Employees and Guest Lecturers) are not eligible to be a candidate for the President and Vice President positions.
- All FSA members may *nominate* and *vote* for these positions.

TERM OF SERVICE

• The President and Vice-President positions will serve a two (2) year term from June 1, 2022 until May 31, 2024.
